Serpentinized ultrabasic rocks outcrop abundantly on Monarch Mountain. Asbestos, consisting of rather harsh chrysotile cross-fibre material, occurs in scattered veinlets one-sixteenth to one-eighth of an inch wide in the serpentine. The best exposure noted was a short irregular 10 foot wide zone containing numerous parallel fractures. Some of the fractures contained cross-fibre asbestos in veinlets one-sixteenth to one-eighth of an inch wide, but many of the fractures were barren. Scattered veinlets of similar length fibres were seen in patches at other widely separated points.

In the summer of 1950 twelve claims, the Heli Nos. 1 to 6 and the Copter Nos. 1 to 6, were located across the top of the mountain. Helicopter Exploration Co., Ltd., made a geological survey of the property and subsequently 4 of the claims were dropped. In 1951 the Heli Nos. 1 to 4 claims were registered in the name of D.M. Cannon, of Vancouver, and the Copter Nos. 1 to 4 claims were registered in the name of Nels Hals, also of Vancouver.
