HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the shore of Atlin Lake about half a mile south of the town of Atlin.

A number of claims adjoining the Atlin townsite on the south and east were staked by various parties in 1898 or 1899. The Nimrod Syndicate, Limited, of London, England, optioned the claims and during the winter of 1899-1900 carried out development work. A 90-foot adit was driven from a point 15 feet above the level of the lake; diamond drilling was also reported; this work was done on the Anaconda and Amy claims. Work was suspended in 1900.

The Anaconda claim (Lot 172) was Crown-granted in 1900 to E.W. Hamilton. The Amy claim lapsed and was restaked in about 1904 by the Shirley Bros. as the Full Moon claim.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The underlying rock is reported to be mainly magnesite or carbonitized serpentinite of the Atlin intrusions. The rock is much intersected by quartz and calcite stringers and seams of oxidized material, and contains disseminated pyrite. On surface the highest gold values were confined to oxidized seams and cavities. The adit, 10 feet from the portal, cut a narrow quartz vein 6 to 9 inches wide; sampling indicated only a trace of gold; what is apparently the same vein outcrops on the surface at 50 feet higher elevation, but is irregular in width and cannot be traced for any distance.
