Chalcocite float was found on the southwest side of the mountain. No actual sulphide showings are known to exist on the claims, although some asbestos has been found.

Associated minerals or products of value - **Asbestos.**

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the northerly and westerly slopes of Mount O'Keefe, approximately 30 miles south-southeast of Atlin.

Totem Minerals Ltd. carried out a geophysical survey on the Cop claim group in 1960.

O'Keefe Mountain Mines Ltd. was incorporated in February 1967 to acquire the Kim, Alice, Nel, and Kathy groups, totalling 34 claims. Work during the year included geological mapping, an electromagnetic survey, and soil and silt geochemical surveys.
