Aitken mentions two copper occurrences on Llewellyn Inlet. The first is a thin stringer of chalcocite, on which a short adit has been driven, on the east shore of the inlet. The second is a copper-stained, pyritized zone on the creek entering the north end of the inlet from the west. A sample of quartz and copper carbonated from the Union group assayed: copper, 6.1% gold; 0.03 ounce a ton; silver, 91.4 ounces a ton.
