O'Donnel River has never been an important producer of gold. Most activity has been in the immediate vicinity of the settlement of O'Donnel, however almost every tributary of the river has yielded some gold. "The O'Donnel River system and with it Wilson and Rapid Roy Creeks, have three things in common: they lack important areas of metamorphosed greenstone within their drainage basins; they carry enough gold, including coarse gold, to have encouraged intensive prospecting; they have never been worked at a profit." (Aitken, 1959, p. 77).

In the vicinity of the settlement of O'Donnel, hydraulicking and drifting on bedrock have been carried on. However, these operations have never been profitable.

A registered production of 6,455 ounces of gold has been recovered from O'Donnel River, between 1898 and 1939. No production was registered for the years from 1901 to 1910.
