HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,000 foot elevation 3 miles east of Swift Lake and 10 miles south of Mile 755 on the Alaska Highway.

The Ram 1-20 claims were owned in 1972 by J.J. Altenburg. Nizi Zinc & Metal Mining Limited optioned the property and carried out a geochemical soil and silt survey (800 samples) covering all claims, and trenching on Ram 6, 11, and 12.
