The claims are underlain by quartzites, argillites, and limestone. On the Tan 3 claim stibnite occurs disseminated in a quartz vein that has an average thickness of 8 inches. The average grade of four representative samples was 7.6% stibnite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 2 miles south of Plate Lake and 4 miles west of Tootsee Lake, about 50 miles north-northwest of Cassiar.
