DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

"The showing contains minor amounts of massive chalcop-  
pyrite with pyrite in sideritic or ankeritic carbonate and  
occurs along the contact between white, massive quartz and  
grey, calcareous phyllite. Locally, the quartz vein is  
ribboned, the well-defined ribbons averaging about 6 inches  
wide. Well-developed quartz crystals are present in white  
quartz a few tens of feet northeast of the main showing".
