Mineralization is reported to consist of massive pyrite, marcasite, sphalerite, galena, and barite fracture fillings in sheared and brecciated dolomite, quartzite, slate and greenstone.

This property is located between Sandpile Lake and the head of Hidden Valley Creek.

In 1964 the Consolidated Mining & Smelting Company of Canada Ltd. held the Vale group of 140 mineral claims by record and 9 other claims by option. Geological mapping, electromagnetic surveys, minor trenching, and 185 feet of diamond drilling in 3 holes were done during the year.
