DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A vein, containing minor disseminated pyrite, chalcopyrite, and free gold, follows the contact between pyroclastic rocks and argillic-slaty rocks, both of the Devonian-Mississippian Sylvester Group.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at approximately 1,525 metres elevation on Table Mountain, 13 kilometres southeast of Cassiar townsite. The claims cover an eastward extension of the Vollaug vein (104 P/4, AU 1).

The Wildcat 1-16 claims were optioned from F.G. Maynes and W.D. Hartman by Yellowstone Mines Ltd. in March 1973. Work by the company in 1973 and in 1975 included geological mapping, sampling, and diamond drilling in 4 holes totalling 44 metres on Wildcat 16. The owners carried out trenching in 1977.

Plaza Resources Corp optioned the Wildcat 1-3, 9, 12-16 claims from Maynes and Hartman in October 1977. Work during 1978-80 included trenching, stripping, a geochemical survey, diamond drilling, and limited open pit test mining. Three zones of economic potential were located. Probable reserves were estimated at 44,000 tons at 0.55 oz/ton Au and 0.42 oz/t Ag (Brodie Hicks Engineering Ltd, 31/04/81, as quoted in Plaza Mining Corporation Application for Listing 188/81).

Plaza Mining Corporation, incorporated February 1980, exchanged its shares for all shares of Plaza Resources Corp, the latter becoming a subsidiary company. The company installed a 120 ton per day mill on the Lulu claim adjacent to Highway 37 some 4 miles northwest of the Wildcat property, to also serve the company's Quartzrock Creek properties. The milling of ore from the Wildcat property was carried out from August 17 to December 14, 1981, when the company was put into receivership. The assets of the company, including the Wildcat claims, were offered for sale by tender in 1982 and were acquired by Erickson Gold Mines Ltd. in 1983. Erickson changed its name to Total Erickson Resources Ltd. Mining operations were suspended in 1988 and Total Erickson amalgamated with Getty Resources Limited to form Getty Resources Limited. The latter became Total Energold Corporation.

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HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION

In 1981 about 10,000 tons of ore averaging about 0.45 oz/t were milled. Subsequent published production statistics are unavailable.
