DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Blebs of darker sphalerite and 1/16 to 1/8 inch veinlets of "white zinc" are in a brecciated dolomite horizon in Cambrian and Ordovician Kechiga Group shale or argillite. A chip sample assayed 4.20% Zn, 0.06% Cd and 0.05 ozs Ag/ton.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The occurrence was found around 1980 by Starscope Minerals Enterprises Inc. as a result of tracing the source of a zinc geochemical anomaly. In March 1981, it was optioned by Gulf Titanium Ltd. as part of the Jackpine, Mustang and Tang 1 & 2 claims.
