## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The rocks are mainly altered andesitic flows close to the contact with the sediments exposed at higher elevations. A vein of white quartz from 2 to 3 feet wide, contains a few rusty cavities. This vein, which strikes westerly and dips 65 degrees southward, is in sheared volcanics which strike north 30 degrees west and dip eastward. In a length of 150 feet the vein is indicated by two cuts, a few outcrops, and some float. A sample taken across 3 feet of well-fractured quartz assayed. Gold, 0.16 oz. per ton; silver, trace.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showing lies at the 3,700 foot elevation about a mile northerly from the mouth of Quartzrock Creek, 5 miles east of Cassiar.

A number of quartz veins were discovered and staked in this vicinity in 1935. The Klondike Fraction claim was owned by Phil Hankin until 1947 or later. The only work reported was trenching.

Hanna Gold Mines Ltd. held the showing from 1961, apparently as the Roy Fraction. Additional claims in the Roy group were purchased in 1972. For subsequent history see: Copco 104 P/5, AU 1.
