DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A buried channel on Quartzrock creek near its confluence with Troutline creek has been mined by drifting and hydraulicking. The old channel was drifted on for about 2,000 feet upstream from where it is cut by the present creek, and for a short distance downstream.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

Placer gold was discovered on McDame creek and its tributaries in 1874 and most of the production was achieved prior to 1895. Small scale operations were continued by D. Wing and associates from the early 1920's. Mr. Wing sold his leases in 1946 to R.G. Wilms and associates, who incorporated Cassiar Yukon Gold Mines Ltd. in 1950; the company charter was surrendered in 1960.
