DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Two sills about 50 and 100 feet thick are exposed for short distances. They consist of highly serpentized peridotite, serpentine, and talc-carbonate rock. At one locality, veinlets of cross-fibre asbestos, up to one inch long but not of good quality, were seen in the serpentine.
