This property is located between elevations of 3,000 and 5,000 feet on Squaw Creek, 12 miles northwest of Mile 87 on the Haines road.

Roque Point Mines Ltd. in August 1966 optioned 18 claims. In 1967 the company held 42 claims in the Sheep and other groups. Work on the property during 1967 included airborne magnetometer and electromagnetic surveys, and diamond drilling in 6 holes totalling 650 feet. A subsidiary company, Copper City Mines Ltd. (N.P.L.), was incorporated in March 1968 to take over the property.
