

MINFILE NTS 104F & G – SUMDUM & TELEGRAPH CREEK

These two maps areas contain 188 recorded mineral occurrences. The western part of the area is underlain by the Coast Crystalline Belt and the remainder by the Intermontane Belt. The area hosts several major mineral occurrences such as **Galore Creek** (104G 090-099, 156, 157) porphyry copper, **Schaft** Creek (104G 015, 032) porphyry copper-molybdenum and the **Spectrum** (104G 036) gold deposits.
