DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claims are underlain by nickeliferous ultramafic rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at approximately 4,500 feet elevation on the south side of Santa Rosa Creek, 8 miles east-southeast of the south end of Christina Lake.

The Basic 1-20 claims were acquired prior to 1971 by Hunter Point Explorations Ltd., a subsidiary of Chromex Nickel Mines Ltd. During 1971 some 2,100 feet of surface diamond drilling was carried out. Based on this work reserves were estimated at some 20,000,000 tons grading about 0.2% nickel. (Ref. Steiner, 1974, p. 4 - in Chromex Nickel Mines, Statement of Materials Facts, July 1974). During 1973 further surface diamond drilling was done in one hole totalling 100 feet on Basic 7.
