In general two types of asbestos were noted- a light greenish-grey variety with fibres up to 4 inches long and a pale-green variety with radiating fibres up to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch long. Both varieties are brittle and break down to a relatively short fibre on crushing and grinding.

A relatively large tonnage is indicated.
