HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at the head of Sitkum Creek, 12 miles north of Nelson, adjoining the Alpine property (82 F/11, Au 1). The location is not known with any degree of accuracy and may in fact be a restaking of ground held in the 1920's as the Noonday group, since the Radcliffe family, of Nelson, was associated with both properties. Data on the Noonday property has arbitrarily been incorporated into the Alpine.

The Gold Crown, owned in 1938 by Mrs. Anna Belle Radcliffe, of Nelson, was operated under lease during 1938-39 by S. Reese & associates. Hand steel was used to mine ore from trenches.

**HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION**

During 1938-39, 42 tons of ore were shipped from this property. From this ore 26 ounces gold, 761 ounces silver, 196 pounds lead, and 142 pounds zinc were recovered.
