The location is not known with any degree of accuracy and may in fact be a restaking of ground held in the 1920's as the Noonday group, since the Radcliffe family, of Nelson, was associated with both properties. Data on the Noonday property has arbitrarily been incorporated into the Alpine.

The Gold Crown, owned in 1938 by Mrs. Anna Belle Radcliffe, of Nelson, was operated under lease during 1938-39 by S. Reese & associates. Hand steel was used to mine ore

from trenches.
