This occurrence consists of a quartz vein 2 feet in width, containing chalcopyrite and pyrite with minor amounts of sphalerite and galena.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property, consisting of 18 located claims, is located on Cottonwood creek, a southerly flowing tributary of Woodbury creek. A road, ½ mile long, was built to the property from a point on Woodbury creek road 6 miles from the Nelson-Kaslo highway.

A group, headed by G. Talbot, held the property in 1951 and did a small amount of surface exploration. They stripped the vein for 50 feet but apparently didn't find any worthwhile mineralization.

No claim names have been given so it is not known if exploration or development work has been carried on previously on any part of this property.
