DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Replacement orebody of lead, zinc and silver in limestone with small amounts of copper. An edit intersected what appears to be a ~~lens~~ lens-type formation some 340 feet from the portal and its structure has a width of 7 feet. The high-grade lens is contained in a limestone band approximately 60 feet wide. A sample over a width of 40 ft averaged 9.70% Ag/ton, 19.99% lead and 7.99% zinc.
