#### DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The north edge of a large area of Cretaceous quartz monzonite is in contact with Proterozoic Horsethief Creek and Lower Cambrian Hamill Group quartzite, slates, and schists. The mineralization, contained mainly in and conforming to the bedding of the altered sedimentaries, but occasionally in the intrusive, consists of masses and disseminations of auriferous pyrite associated with quartz and siliceous gangue; gold values in the sulphide material were reported (1926) to be "too low to be of interest". Narrow seams and fractures, cutting across the trend of the rocks, contain gold values in decomposed siliceous gangue. A sample across one of these fractures, 6 inches wide, assayed 2.84 oz/t Au.

The property is located on the north side of Fry Creek, just east of the junction with Carney Creek and some 16 km southeast of the north end of Kootenay Lake.

High gold assays were reported from the Gold Bug claim in 1893 but its location is unknown. D.M. Wadams and associates, of Johnson Landing, found the source of placer gold and staked the Lookout 1-3, Rainbow and Goat Cliff claims prior to 1925. Prospecting and development work by the owners continued into 1930: in 1926 the workings consisted of short adits, a shallow shaft, and open cuts scattered along some 3.000' length of the geological contact, but mainly on the Lookout claim above the creek junction.
