DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The formation consists principally of limestone, dipping steeply. A quartz vein, from 1 to 2 feet wide, is located along a northerly trending fault zone. Mineralization consists principally of galena, associated with pyrite and sphalerite, and carrying high values in silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located at the 9,000 foot elevation at the head of Red Line Creek, a tributary of McDonald Creek, and adjoins the Ptarmigan group on the south.

The Tecumseh group, consisting of the Tecumseh, Tuscumby, and Dundee claims, was staked by W. Haupt in 1900. Some work was done on the property each year until 1908. Small shipments of high-grade ore were made from the underground workings, which totalled some 135 feet of drifts in 3 adits.

The Tecumseh group of claims apparently lapsed and the Nip & Tuck and Silver Tip claims were a restaking of the showings by W. Haupt and T. Brown in 1915. Small amounts of high-grade ore were shipped in 1915 and 1916.

The property was optioned by W.D. McMillan and V. Sontag in 1919. During 1920 work was carried on by an unnamed syndicate. Interprovincial Mines Development Company Limited optioned the property in 1922 and some work was done on a high-grade outcrop.

No further work was reported until 1927 when Trethwood Mining Company Limited acquired the property, now expanded to 6 claims and fractions. A contract was let for driving a 600 foot crosscut tunnel, however, no work has been reported done on this project.

In 1964 Golden Gate Explorations Limited acquired the Nip and Tuck group and expanded the property to 26 claims.

HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION

Production from the Tecumseh and Paymaster claims during the period 1904-1907, and from the Nip & Tuck claim during the period 1915-1923 totalled 177 tons. From this ore 1 ounce of gold, 14,799 ounces of silver, and 181,473 pounds of lead were recovered.
