DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Widely spaced quartz stringers carrying galena, sphalerite, pyrite, and pyrrhotite occur in fractured metasediments.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showings are located at approximately 4,600 feet elevation on the east side of Foghorn Creek, 3 miles south of Birch Island.

The Minnesota Girl group was owned during the 1920's by J.W. Schlichter and associates of Birch Island. Exploration was carried out in surface workings and in a crosscut adit which was extended to 322 feet in 1930.

This ground was included in the property acquired by Rexspar Uranium & Metals Mining Co. Limited in 1951, the workings probably being covered in part at least by the Rex 13 claim (Lot 5403). Subsequent work was directed towards fluorspar and uranium (see: 82 M/12, FSP 1 and U 1).
