Map 48-1936 indicates the area is underlain by Palaeozoic or Earlier volcanic and sedimentary rocks.

The Venus and Evelyn groups comprising 4 claims were owned by C.F. Johnson and associates from about 1927 to 1932. Exploration work was done in numerous trenches and pits, which readily filled with water. An electrical survey was carried out in 1931 and the results were investigated by a 29 foot shaft sunk in 1932.

The ground was held as the Whisky Jack (WJ 1-4) and Silver Weasel claims in 1984 but details are lacking.
