The ore, a high-grade resinous sphalerite, lies against the southern contact of a very prominent limestone bed which strikes almost at right-angles across Adams Lake at this point.

The Rose group of claims lies about 5 miles north of Skwaam (Agate) Bay on the west shore of Adams Lake. The showing, staked by I. Bennett, was held under option by Tombac Explorations Ltd. during 1961. A total of 1,575 feet of diamond drilling was done before the option was dropped.
