HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property consists of 6 claims, located about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Cedarside. In November 1960 a pilot plant for processing mica was put into operation and in May 1961 the company was producing 15 tons of flake mica per day. In 1962 a new plant, having a capacity in excess of 30 tons per day, was completed and brought into operation.

Diamond drilling has indicated some 200,000 tons of 85% to 90% mica to a depth of 12 feet. This estimate is based on the results of 18 drill holes in an area 500 feet square, some of which were drilled to a depth of 40 feet without reaching the limits of the mica-bearing body.
