DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Two veins containing copper, gold and silver values have been found in a volcanic rock formation. One vein is reported as assaying 2.6% copper across a width of 17 feet, while the other vein, known as the "high grade vein", averages about 14% copper across 3.5 feet. Mineralization in vein outcrops has been traced for 1,200 feet.

Associated minerals or products of value - Gold, silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located near the southeast end of Great Central Lake, northwest of Alberni, Vancouver Island. The claims were staked around 1953 by Cecil Dixon, Ken Wickwire and associates. Exploration work in open cuts was reported.
