G. S. C., Memoir No. 26, 1911, p. 144. (Camsell, C.)	"In 1892 the Tulameen Improvement Co. began opera- tions on a bench on the Tulameen river below the mouth of Eagle Creek. A saw-mill was imported, at a time when the only means of transport was pack horses, and set up at the mouth of Eagle Creek. A flume was built to convey water from Eagle Creek, and hydraulicking operations were carried on for two seasons, under the direction of Judge Murphy. The proportion of gold to platinum at this point was about one to two, and the recovery of platinum was high; but the available ground was limited, and the results obtained did not pay for the cost of plant and management." (G.S.C., Memoir 26.)
