"Champion Creek joins the Tulameen from the South, nearly 2 miles above Eagle Creek. Its valley is similar to those of many other tributaries of the Tulameen, having a narrow rock-walled canyon near its mouth and a broader flaring valley above. Good prospects have been obtained in gold and platinum from the gravels above the canyon, but the ground is deep and has not been bottomed. There are virtually no gravels in the canyon portion, at the mouth of the stream."
