DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Mineralized shear zones occur in the southern margin of a small stock (Otter intrusions) which cuts Coast intrusions. The shear zones strike easterly, are in part silicified and carry considerable pyrite and minor sphalerite and galena over widths of a few inches to 1 foot. A selected sample from the upper adit, taken by the Resident Engineer, assayed 0.1 oz/t Au, 269.8 oz/t Ag. Rice (1947) found a number of fine seams of fluorite occupying joints in the altered granite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on Siwash Creek, about a mile north of Teepee Creek, some 23 miles north-northeast of Princeton.

The property was owned by the Claremont Syndicate from prior to 1917; in that year the workings included open cuts and 500' of crosscuts and drifts in 3 adits.

Claims were held in this vicinity in the 1920's and 1950's. In 1968 Spa Mines Limited held 103 claims in this vicinity; bulldozer trenching was reported. Quality Exploration Corporation carried out a magnetometer survey in 1969.

About 200 claim units were held on Siwash creek in 1979 by D. Agar and E. Mullin. Brenda Mines Ltd optioned the property. Work included geochemical and geophysical surveys, trenching and diamond drilling.
