The holdings of this Company consisted of 640 acres of bench land, and were situated on the South Fork of the Similkameen river, about 9 mls. up stream from Princeton.

The first piping was done in 1896, when the Company had a large force of men employed for about 3 months. Operations then ceased, as the result of the wash-up was not satisfactory.
