"South side of Tulameen above the last (Collin's Gulch). Gold rather heavy. A little work done. One claim gave \$10 a day to the hand the first season. Coarse platinum found with the gold."

"Cedar Creek is a small stream flowing into the Tulameen river about 2 mls. above Otter Creek. No work is now being done on it, but when mined some years ago it yielded both gold and platinum. The stream is about 2½ mls. long." (G.S.C., Memoir 26.) (Goarse grains & Pellets of platinum were found.)
