The property was staked (20 claims) in August 1938 by Lester Starnes, of Ashcroft. Exploration work in open cuts and a 50' adit was carried out by J.O. Williams for the Calgary Mineral Syndicate; the claims subsequently lapsed. The ground was restaked (3 claims ?) by T. Blakiston-Gray of Lytton and his associates, but no work was reported.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 1010 A indicates the property is underlain by Permian and (?) later greenstone. Open cuts exposed chromite sparsely distributed in narrow seams in serpentine. Over mining widths this material is not likely to be over 10 to 15 per cent chromite. Small lenses of high grade occurs in a very pale green phase of the serpentine. One such lense, some 5' across by 10' long is reported to have assayed over 50% chromite.
