DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The showings consist of quartz lenses about three inches wide carrying stibnite and galena. The lenses appear to follow some definite fissuring which strikes north 40° east and dips 45° southeast.

Associated minerals or products of value - Lead.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

These claims are situated above the mouth of Gun Creek, near the Reliance Group (92 J/15, Sb 2). Messrs. Jones, Christie and Smith staked the claims in about 1910. Work on the showings was done in several open cuts.
