HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The King group, consisting of twenty-eight claims, is situated between 4,800 and 5,600 feet elevation on the summit between Carpenter and Seton Lakes, two miles east of Mission Mountain Road.

In 1967, Benn Explorations Ltd. optioned the property from Paul Matson. Work included geological mapping, 12 trenches totalling 240 lineal feet and 1,000 square feet of stripping.
