DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Jurassic Bonanza volcanics.
Triassic Quatsino limestones lie to the north.
A copper geochemical anomaly occurs on the volcanics.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showing is located 2 miles north of the east end of Bay Lake at 300 feet elevation.

In 1967 Utah Construction & Mining Co. carried out a geochemical survey on the property owned by Gordon Melbourne.

During 1971 work on the Rib and Reef group of 24 claims included electromagnetic and magnetometer surveys.
