Chalcopyrite, sphalerite, and pyrite occur in skarn zones at the footwall and hangingwall contacts of a limestone band in Karmutsen volcanics.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located about 4 miles northwest of the east end of Rupert Inlet at an elevation of 600 feet.

In 1959 the Frances property of eight recorded claims was owned by J. Manson and G.K. Storey. The Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company of Canada, Limited, optioned the property in 1959. The Company carried out cutting and trenching for a total of 4,788 cubic yards. The option was terminated in September 1959.
