Magnetite and minor pyrite and chalcopyrite is disseminated in silicified andesite of the Bonanza subgroup.

A channel sample across three feet assayed: 0.20% copper; 12.5% iron; 0.35% TiO₂; 0.01 ounces per ton gold; and a trace of silver.
