DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Upper Triassic Karmutsen volcanic rocks are cut by several granodiorite porphyry dykes. Pyrite, pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite occur locally in quartz veining and in bunches in a calcareous horizon and adjacent tuffs. A selected sample assayed: copper, 5.14%; gold, 0.08 oz/ton; silver, 0.92 oz/ton.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at approximately 1,300' elevation on the northeast side of Nomash River 9 km northeast of Zeballos.

The showings were prospected and staked as the King claim by Alfred Bird and associates in the early 1930's.

Malaspina Mining Company Limited held the showings as the Rugged and Black Knight claims in 1967. Geological, geophysical and geochemical surveys were carried out.
