Upper Triassic Quatsino Formation limestone forms an irregular westerly trending contact with Eocene quartz-diorite. Chalcopyrite, bornite and pyrite mineralization occur in bunches at a granite-skarn contact.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on the south side of Nomash River, about 1 km southeast of its junction with Zeballos River and 8 km northeast of Zeballos.

The Climax group of 6 claims was owned in the 1930's by the Climax Syndicate. In 1938 Delphine Mines, Limited prospected the showing by means of trenches and four short adits. The Climax No. 12 (Lot 1882) and Black Knight 1-7 (Lots 1871-1877 respectively) were Crown-granted.

Consolidated Skeena Mines Ltd. held the Black Knight group and the Sonny claim in 1966. Work included an electromagnetic survey, surface diamond drilling in 3 holes totalling 1,110', and underground drilling in one hole totalling 531' from the face of No. 2 adit of the adjoining Central Zeballos property (92 L/2, AU 16).
