HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at an elevation of 1,000 feet on the northwest side of Teeta Creek one mile southwest of Neroutsos Inlet.

The White Quartz claim was owned by Messrs. Nordstrom and Sargison. They drove a 100-foot adit in 1903.

OWNER OR OPERATOR AND ADDRESS

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Lower Jurassic Bonanza volcanics intruded by a body of granodiorite.

The mineralization occurs in altered granite porphyry in several quartz stringers and in a 21-foot wide brecciated white quartz vein striking N25°E with near vertical dip. The mineralization consists of copper and iron pyrites containing values in gold.
