DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 29-1963 indicates this vicinity is underlain by Palaeozoic sediments of the Cache Creek Group including limestone, argillite, chert and greywacke. Pyrolusite occurs as disseminated grains and irregular stringers in a quartz vein that is reported to be up to 4 feet wide and traceable for 500 feet. An 84 pound sample assayed by Mines Branch, Ottawa, gave 39.82% MnO₂.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on the east side of the Fraser River some 13 miles south-southwest of the community of Williams Lake.

The showings were held in the early 1940's by A. Haddock, of Williams Lake, and F.B. Bass, J.L. Lauthiers, and John Davis, as the Lilly M Nos. 1 and 2 claims. Trenching was carried out by the owners in 1941 and an ore sample was shipped to Mines Branch, Ottawa.

Newon Manganese Mining Co. Limited held an option on the property in 1942. The surface outcrop was stripped by bulldozer and a short incline was driven to prospect the downward extension of the mineralized zone, with unsatisfactory results. Diamond drilling in 4 holes totalling 470 feet failed to intersect ore at depth and the option was given up.
