DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The chalcopyrite, pyrite, pyrrhotite, and magnetite comprise a contact metasomatic deposit near an intrusion of diorite into volcanic rocks, both of Jurassic age.

Associated minerals or products of value - Iron.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on Gibbons Creek, 10 miles E of Horsefly.

In 1966, Helican Explorations Limited carried out geological mapping, electromagnetic, I.P., ground and air-borne magnetometer, and geochemical surveys. Trenching, stripping and drilling were also done.

In 1967, the property was optioned to Magnum Consolidated Mining Co. Ltd. This company carried out 1,400 feet of drilling in 3 holes, during 1967.

Magnum still held the property in 1970 when the company was taken over by Brameda Resources Ltd.
