DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

"Along Nechako River, north of Kenney Dam, large blocks of lignite are strewn along the exposed river bottom, but a careful search failed to disclose their source. Dawson (1878, p. 82) reported a 4-foot seam along Nechako River near Mount Greer but this was not seen - possibly is no longer exposed. The blocks are sufficiently large to suggest that such a seam does exist. In all probability the lignite is inter-basalt or is from the base of the plateau basalts and hence of late Tertiary age". (Tipper, 1963, p. 55).
