DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT  
 The mineralization occurs as disseminated chalcopyrite and tetrahedrite in altered volcanic and intrusive rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
 The property is located on Mouse Mountain, at an approximate elevation of 3,300 feet, and 14 miles due east of Quesnel. In 1966, this group of 28 claims was optioned by the Granby Mining Company Limited from Mr. C. Fuller. Geological and geophysical surveys, along with some stripping and trenching were done on the claims during that year. In 1970, Bethlehem Copper Corporation Ltd. owned the W 1-69 and Wanda 1-20 claims and fractions. Their assessment work that year included 1,400 feet of percussion drilling in seven holes on Wanda 5-8.
