Exposures occur at intervals for about half a mile along the river and from about 300 feet west of and 40 feet above the waters edge. Holes drilled by hand-auger indicate the deposit is at least 35 feet thick. The deposit is considered to be of Tertiary age, sedimentary in origin, flat-lying, and extensive. The clay is said to be of high quality.

This deposit is located on Lot 3991 on the west bank of the Fraser River near the foot of Giscome Rapids, about 18 miles north of Prince George.

Samples of the clay were sent out for testing as early as 1913 but no development work was reported at that time. In 1942 the property was owned by F.J. Beale, who stripped an area approximately 100 feet square on the river bank and 20 tons of clay were mined and shipped to Vancouver. Holes were drilled by hand-auger on the stripped area in 1947; drill samples were tested by the Mines Branch, Ottawa.
