## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A few closely spaced quartz veins a fraction of an inch wide strike eastward and dip steeply to the north in scarcely altered, fairly coarse grained granite and contain small amounts of specularite and traces of molybdenite.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at an elevation of about 2,800 feet on the northerly slope of Nithi Mountain, approximately 4 miles south-southeast of the village of Fraser Lake.

The M.J.M. group of 11 claims and fractions were acquired in 1964 by Marvin Sherman and M. and J. Bibley. Scope Development Ltd. held an option on the property during 1964-65. The only activity reported was prospecting in 1964.

Nithex Exploration and Development Ltd. was incorporated by Messrs. Sherman and Bibley in January 1970. Work on the M.J.M. group during the year included a geochemical survey and trenching.
