DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Diamond drilling cut pink granite, dykes of amygdular basalt, and biotitic feldspar porphyry. On the average the amount and degree of alteration is small and the amount of molybdenite mineralization very limited.

In the drill holes, quartz monzonite, which is fractured and sheared but not otherwise greatly altered, locally contains narrow quartz veins with pyrite and a little molybdenite. Other molybdenite occurs locally as a varnish on shear surfaces in strong chloritic faults.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located 3½ miles south-southwest of Endako and about 2 miles east of Endako Mines Ltd.

The CM group of claims was acquired by Torwest Resources (1962) Ltd. in 1963. An electromagnetic survey of the property by Scope Mining and Exploration located three westerly trending conductors. Additional work included geochemical soil sampling, and diamond drilling totalling 2,719 feet in 7 holes. The best drill intersection, from 210 to 330 feet, assayed 0.24% MoS₂.

Endako Mines Ltd. optioned the CM group in 1967 and carried out 4,123 feet of diamond drilling in 15 holes; a further 3,897 feet of diamond drilling in 13 holes was completed by Endako Mines in 1968.
